



Flying Your US Glider In Canada

The procedure to fly your "Experimental" glider in Canada is now called a "Validation of Foreign Flight Authority".¹

Please scan your Certificate of Registration and special Certificate of Airworthiness with the Letter stating the Operating Limitations. PDF format is preferred.

Then, there is a fee of CAD \$100 and you should be able to pay this with Visa or MC by phone at (800)305-2059. Note this receipt number in your package of scanned documents.

Send the documents and the following request to AEginternal-GEAinterne@tc.gc.ca for processing.

Request permission to fly your American registered glider licensed in the "Experimental" category at the Canadian National Gliding Championships to be held at **Arthur, ON between July 30th and August 15th**. Dates include practice as well as weekends before, and after the contest.
